# TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress and shall be governed by USBC Youth rules.
2. Only entrants certified in the current 2025/2026 Cecil Harford USBC league with a 12-game minimum by closing date (November 15, 2025) will be permitted to enter this competition.
3. Competition shall be conducted in the following six (6) divisions. These divisions are based on the participant's age as of **July 31, 2025**. There will be separate divisions for boys and girls.

**Preps – up to 11 years**

**Juniors – 12 to 14 years**

**Majors – 15 to 18 years**

4. **The tournament closing date is November 15, 2025.** No entry fees will be refunded.
5. The tournament format shall be: All Divisions will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes. Top qualifiers (boys and girls) will compete in a one (1) game stepladder finals to determine scholarship winners. (See rule #7)
6. A one game roll off will break a tie for stepladder finalists only. Should a tie still exist, an additional 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off will be used to break the tie.
7. A stepladder final will be held for both divisions to determine the handicap champion. If there are more than 25 participants in a division, the top 5 qualifiers will advance to the stepladder finals. Less than 25 participants, the top 3 qualifiers will advance.
8. Entrants shall use their highest certified average established in any USBC youth certified league from the previous season (winter & summer) 2024-2025 based on 21 games or more.

If an entrant has no previous season (2024-2025) yearbook certified USBC average, they must use their highest current season's (2025-2026) USBC youth certified average for 12 games or more from any Association per USBC Rule 319a-1. In addition, entrants must furnish a league standing sheet with written verification from their league secretary as of the closing date of the tournament.

If eligibility requirements are met and bowler doesn't meet the average requirements, they must bowl scratch.

9. Scholarships will be based on at least a 1 in 5 ratio. The tournament committee reserves the right to rule on the final disbursement of the scholarship money. All scholarships will be deposited into the bowler's USBC SMART Scholarship account and will be available to be disbursed to colleges upon high school graduation.
10. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. Please see Rule #301b. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No hats/caps will be worn during the tournament. The Tournament Director will make all decisions regarding dress code.
11. NO USE OF CELL PHONES, HEADPHONES, AND EAR BUDS WHILE BOWLING. Request for waiver must be in writing prior to tournament competition. For medical purposes only.
12. **NO SMOKING OR VAPING IS PERMITTED BY USBC YOUTH PARTICIPANTS. PARENTS AND TOURNAMENT OFFICIALS WISHING TO SMOKE MUST DO SO IN DESIGNATED ONLY.**
13. Only bowlers and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.
14. The Tournament Director shall decide on any questions not covered by these rules. Any appeal or protest and claims of error must be made in accordance with USBC rules within 48 hours of competition. Under this rule, each protest must be specific.
15. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the Tournament Director.
