TOURNAMENT RULES:

- 1. All eligible youth bowlers certified in the current 2025-26 Cecil-Harford USBC league (with 21 games minimum) will be permitted to enter this tournament. Please submit league standing sheets through December 4, 2025.
- 2. **WALK–INS WILL BE ALLOWED BASED ON LANE AVAILABILITY**. Registration closing date is December 5, 2025. No entries will be accepted without full fees and all requested information completed.
- 3. All bowlers must check in 30 minutes prior to the start of the tournament. All bowlers must present 2025-2026 USBC membership card at check-in.
- 4. Tardy players will receive zero for all frames missed.
- 5. The format will be a 4-game qualifier to advance to the stepladder final. Stepladder final will have at least five (5) bowlers based on the number of entries. There will be a 9th and 10th frame roll off for ties to determine positions.
- 6. Scholarships will be based on at least a 1 in 7 ratio. The tournament committee reserves the right to rule on the final disbursement of the scholarship money. All scholarships will be deposited into the bowler's USBC SMART Scholarship account (Cecil Harford USBC Youth #12729) and will be available to be disbursed to colleges upon high school graduation.
- 7. All bowlers must wear suitable attire. No hats will be worn while bowling. No participant shall be permitted to use electronic devices, tobacco products, drink alcoholic beverages or use foul language and must remain within the assigned lanes during tournament play. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
